

Poppy patterns

Abbreviations

ch – chain

htr – half treble

K – Knit

P – Purl

K2tog/P2tog – Knit/Purl 2 together

Dpn's – double pointed needles

Blousy crocheted poppy

Using 5mm hook and Aran yarn, or 4mm hook and DK, ch2, or use magic circle.

Round 1: 10htr in 2nd ch from hook (or into magic circle) (10htr)

Round 2: 2htr in each htr around (20htr)

Round 3: 2htr in each hdc around (40htr)

Round 4: 2htr in 1st stitch, 1htr in next htr, repeat to end of round (60htr)

Round 5: 1htr in each stitch around
Fasten off and finish off as below.



Ribbed knitted poppy

Worked on straight needles.

Using 5mm and Aran yarn, or 4mm needles and DK, cast on 80sts in red.

Work **4 rows** in K2 P2 rib

Row 5: *K2tog, P2tog *Repeat across the row (40sts)

Work **3 rows** in K1 P1 rib

Row 9: Change to black, P1 row

Row 10: K2tog across the row (20sts)

Row 11: P2tog across the row (10sts)

Cut yarn and thread through the remaining sts, tighten and secure
Sew up the side of the poppy. Finish off as below.



Finishing off (all versions)

Weave in red ends. Secure black tails with a couple of stitches, do not cut short. Tie two ends together across the back of the poppy and leave tails to fasten to the display.
