# **Mayor's 500 Fund**

#### **Executive Mayor Andy** Abrahams has launched a scheme to support community projects in Mansfield district.

In his first major initiative since being elected, the Mayor is donating 30% of his annual allowance to the Mayor's 500 Fund, which aims to support 24 projects each year.

Three times a year groups, charities and individuals will be able to apply for a £500 grant to support projects in their area. The funding can be used for revenue or capital projects but it must bring direct benefit to the community. The grant can be used for things such as running costs and technology, materials and events.

The fund will be administered by the council's finance team and approved by a panel of officers and the Mayor. Grants will be paid in September, January and May, The first round of applications is now open.

# Plastic pollution

We are more aware than ever of the damage single-use plastics cause to our environment.

This is partly thanks to programmes such as David Attenborough's Blue Planet highlighting the threat to our oceans and wildlife.

As a result of the public outcry, many pubs and restaurants have stopped providing plastic straws and shops and supermarkets are reducing their packaging.

#### If in doubt, leave it out

We all have a duty to reduce the amount of plastic waste we produce and recycle more.

At home you can recycle paper, cardboard, tins, cans, plastic bottles (without their lids), plastic yoghurt pots and margarine tubs by putting these

If you aren't sure if something is recyclable,please don't put it in your recycling bin.

in your blue bin. Items should be empty, clean and dry.

All homes across Nottinghamshire (with the exception of Nottingham City) recycle these same items. They are agreed by the waste disposal authority Nottinghamshire County Council and their waste contractor Veolia.

If you aren't sure if something is recyclable, please don't put it in your recycling bin. Put it in your green household waste bin. This will ensure that entire lorry loads of recyclable waste are not rejected due to contamination.

### **Facts and figures**

Mansfield district has one of the lowest recycling rates in Nottinghamshire. Since 1 March, five bin lorry loads of recyclable waste have been rejected at the recycling plant due to contamination and sent for incineration. This is a total of 76.5 tonnes of waste.

Our aim is for no more than 5% of our district's recycling waste to be contaminated but in May the figure was as high as 13.9%.

# Payback Update boost for parks

Convicted offenders have been paying back for their crimes by working with Mansfield District Council on grounds maintenance projects in Mansfield Woodhouse.

Derbyshire, Leicestershire, Nottinghamshire and Rutland Community Rehabilitation Company community payback teams have been attending for one day a week at the Manor Sports Complex and two days a week at Yeoman Park since April and are due to start work at Racecourse Park in Mansfield.

At Manor they have been clearing weeds and over hanging branches in the car park and tidying the paths. They have also painted the interior and exterior of the bowling pavilion. At Racecourse Park they will be giving the interior of the changing rooms a new look.

#### Be aware of fire danger



The council is reminding residents to be aware of the dangers that fire can cause the natural environment a year after a devastating blaze damaged about 60% of Oak Tree Heath. The heath, an important Site of Special Scientific Interest, lost a significant amount of its flora and fauna and its recovery could take many years.

#### Will orchard fly the flag?



Friends' group, which works with the council to maintain the orchard off Teversal Avenue, is hoping to achieve its first ever Green Flag Community Award.

The council was also due to hear this month (July) if our seven parks and local nature reserves retained their Green Flags.



In July 1969 Neil Armstrong took mankind's first steps on the Moon and uttered his now iconic line: 'That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind.'

This is an even more amazing achievement when you realise that in the 50 years since, just 12 people have walked on the Moon. Mansfield and Sutton Astronomical Society is working with the Museum to celebrate this anniversary.

It was not until the start of the 20th century that technology made a trip to the Moon more than just a flight of fancy.

At the end of the war, Allied forces captured many German rockets. factories and scientists. Both the USA and the Soviet Union used these assets to advance the space race in the 1950s and 1960s.

As always there will be lots for children to do and a programme of hands-on science activity workshops.

The exhibition opens on Saturday 20 July so come along over the summer to . find out about all things space related.
