GREEK HEAD WREATH

Greek laurel wreaths were once given to a victorious winner. Why not make a head wreath and be a winner in whatever you choose.

You will need:

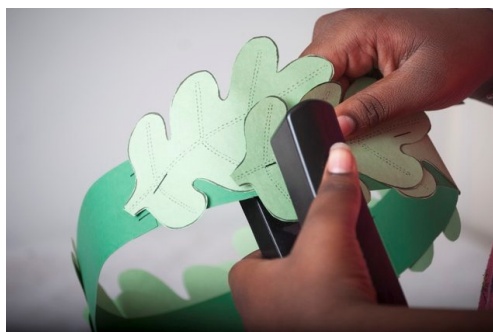
Green paper or card, a stapler, scissors, glue, green glitter or felt tip pens.



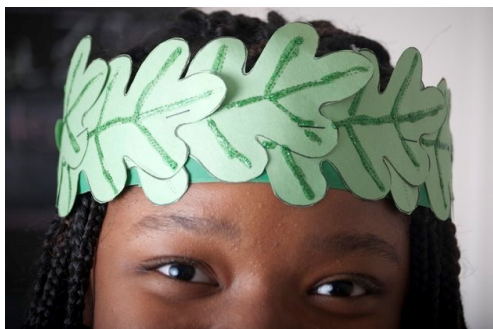
1) Cut a long length of green paper or card to fit around your head and staple together as shown. (You may need a grown up to help you.)



2) Cut out leaf shapes out of green paper. Add the lines onto the leaves with green felt pens or glitter pens. These make the leaves look real.



3) Attach the leaves to the headband either with glue or a stapler. Overlap them slightly so that you cannot see the headband once they are all stuck on.



4) Fit the wreath on your head and wear it. It should sit comfortably on your head, resting just above your ears.
