- ✓ Aerosol cans



Plastics

- ✓ Drinks bottles (e.g. pop, squash, milk)
- ✓ Shower gel and shampoo bottles
- ✓ Cleaning product bottles
- ✓ Yoghurt pots
- ✓ Margarine tubs



Cardboard

- ✓ Cereal boxes
- ✓ Egg boxes
- ✓ Cardboard tubes

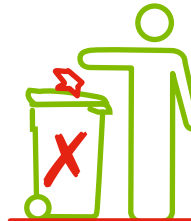

- ✗ Food Trays
- ✗ Fruit and Veg punnets
- ✗ Juice cartons
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Bubble wrap
- ✗ Bottle lids
- ✗ Plastic containers
- ✗ Food pouches
- ✗ Coat hangers
