Local good causes have received their first payments of money raised through Robin Hood Lottery ticket sales.

At the time of writing, the top beneficiaries so far were John Eastwood Hospice Trust (£466.50), SSG Suicide Support Group Mansfield (£210) and Mansfield Soup Kitchen (£194).

The 72 good causes that are signed up stand to receive an estimated total of £49,500 in the first year based on the current levels of play.

The biggest cash prize to date is £250 won by a resident of Warsop. Other players



have each won £25, while many more have won three extra tickets.

Tickets are only £1 per week with 60p going to local good causes and prizes up to £25,000.



Top cycle race whizzing into Mansfield



ansfield is again gearing up to welcome the OVO Energy Tour of Britain cycle race - one the UK's biggest free-to-attend sporting events.

Organisers of the prestigious race, which attracts 120 of the world's top cycling stars, credited the county for its outstanding community engagement and warm welcome, which helped us secure involvement for the second year in a row.

This time Mansfield will host the end of the penultimate Stage 7, the longest stage in the race, which starts in West Bridgford on Saturday 8 September and winds its way around Nottinghamshire for 225km (139 miles), taking in landmarks such as the new Sherwood Forest Visitor centre, Newstead Abbey, and Clumber Park. About five miles of the route will pass through Mansfield district.

Last year more than 200,000 people lined the county's streets and the race generated almost £3.5 million in revenue for the area. In Mansfield. it is estimated that visitor spending brought £167,500 into the local economy.

This year, those figures are expected to be even higher, with the event being held on a weekend - and we need

We will be bringing a real festival atmosphere to the Tour of Britain finish line by combining it with one of our annual summer park events.

This year, our town centre Summer Festival will be held in Chesterfield Road Park on Saturday 8 September to coincide with the Tour of Britain excitement.

The event will run from 11am to 4pm and as well as being able to watch the race as it comes to a dramatic finish outside the Civic Centre and explore the Tour of Britain Village, there will be lots of fun, games and cycling activities for all the family.

Attractions will include:

- Watt bike challenges, which measure the energy expended while pedalling
- Cycling skills competitions
- Have a go on a pump track
- Family sports activities
- Children's road cycling skills sessions
- Balance workshop
- Walkabout entertainers
- Free craft activities
- Freebie giveaways
- Stalls and information stands
- E-bike have-a-go sessions
- Cycling proficiency zones.

The nearest car park will be in the town centre – so why not arrive on two wheels? The town centre car parks will be open but may be affected by rolling road closures between 2pm and 4.30pm so arrive early and come and enjoy the festival!

Five-mile sprin to the finish

8 September 11 am to 4pm



he 225km (139 mile) Nottinghamshire stage of the event will include eight kilometres (five miles) through Mansfield district with the finishing line of the stage outside the Civic Centre on Chesterfield Road South.

The race will enter the district at Derby Road, passing Vision West Nottinghamshire College before turning left on to Nottingham Road and left again at High Oakham School onto Atkin Lane.

The cyclists will then head down High Oakham Hill and onto Sheepbridge Lane to the junction at the Sir John Cockle pub where they will cross straight over Sutton Road and up Skegby Lane before turning right at the Fox and Crown junction on to Beck Lane.

They will then continue on to Abbott Road up to The Rufford pub junction where they will turn right for the final sprint along Chesterfield Road South with the chequered flag finish outside the Civic Centre. The cyclists will then ride into Chesterfield Road Park via Rosemary Street where they will dismount.

Disruption includes all-day road closure near finish line

We expect road closures and travel to be disrupted in Mansfield from 2.30pm to around 4.30pm.

However, an area around the finish line, which will include the Tour of Britain race village, the gantry and hospitality area, will need to be closed all day.

the event, we are encouraging people to cycle wherever possible - bike racks will be provided.

This means Chesterfield Road South will be fully closed in both directions from the junction at Albion Street to the Civic Centre from 5am to 8pm.

Residents along Chesterfield Road South, which is the final kilometre of the race, will have special access, manned by security personnel, until 1.30pm but after that, only emergency vehicles will be able to enter and exit until around 4.30pm.

The council has directly informed businesses and residents in the affected area as early as possible to enable them to make arrangements well ahead of the event.

No deliveries, parking or stopping will be possible during the closure. Pedestrian access will be limited during the site setup between 5am and 11.15am.

We expect 20,000 people to visit Mansfield so heavy traffic is expected along with rolling road closures. Please be aware that you will need to plan ahead to avoid delays. Bus routes and timings will also be affected.

During the rolling closures, the roads are expected to be closed about 20 minutes before the cyclists' arrival and will remain closed until all riders and vehicles have passed. Diversions will be in place and signposted.

Please do not park anywhere along the route on the day. It will be marked with yellow warning signs in the run-up to the event. If necessary, vehicles may have to be removed.

All details, including times, are subject to change so please check the website for the most up to date details.

educe and recycle!

Plastic is found in virtually everything these days from food packaging to chewing gum.


While some plastics are recyclable, many are not and with a worldwide drive to reduce the amount of plastic thrown away, many people are looking at ways to reduce the amount of plastic in their lives.

So how can you help? Here are some ideas.

- Say goodbye to plastic straws and cutlery.
- Reuse plastic bags. They can't be recycled and can take 1,000 years to degrade in landfill. Opt for cotton bags instead.
- Buy products such as laundry detergent and soap in cardboard boxes. which is more easily recycled, instead of plastic bottles.
- Where possible, buy foods that come loose and use paper or reusable bags. Reuse plastic containers to store food.
- Buy a reusable bottle or cup rather than buying bottled water or using throwaway coffee cups.
- Use matches rather than disposable plastic lighters.
- Visit Mansfield Market to buy fruit, veg, meat and fish it will probably have less plastic packaging than supermarket produce and you'll be supporting local independent traders.

The bin crews will only be able to take it if it's small enough to fit in the back of the lorry so make sure you reduce its size by crushing or folding it.

Don't forget to remove any internal packaging, such as polystyrene and bubble wrap, as these materials cannot be recycled.

A small amount of occasional side waste can be accepted on recycling collections. It must be placed in a cardboard box or paper bag.

If you regularly create more waste than will fit in your blue bin, you can ask for a bigger 360-litre recycling bin or an extra 240-litre bin. They're free – subject to a recycling audit first.

Flagship social housing scheme set to open

he new tenants and owners of the council's flagship housing project, Town View, for people aged 55 and over, are expected to take up residence in the £8.54m development in September.

Final touches are being put in place at the site of Mansfield's former General Hospital, which had been derelict for about 20 years before the council bought it for redevelopment.

A total of 54 new homes have been built, including 12 two-bedroom bungalows and 42 one-bedroom and two-bedroom apartments.

Six of the bungalows have already been reserved by buyers for shared ownership, while tenants for other bungalows and apartments have now also been allocated via the council's Homefinder service.

Ten of the apartments, funded by £400,000 from Nottinghamshire County Council, have been allocated to people with extra care needs and who might otherwise need residential care.



The development was also supported by £126,000 from Homes England.

The apartment block has communal facilities, including a lounge, dining room and an outdoor terraced area. The secure landscaped grounds feature a 'village green' with outdoor fitness equipment.

Last chance to comment on planning blueprint

Residents will soon have a final chance to comment on Mansfield's proposed Local Plan before it is considered by Government inspectors.

A 'publication draft' of the Plan is due to be considered by councillors in September and will be submitted to Ministry for Housing, Communities and Local Government in November/December for independent examination.

Following the independent examination in public, if the Local Plan is found sound, the council will formally adopt the Plan as a blueprint for how the district will develop commercially and residentially and how the environment will be protected until 2033.

When the latest consultation begins, you can comment on the 'soundness' of the Plan. This can cover issues such as whether or not areas earmarked for development are the most appropriate sites and can deliver

the required development, and if the Plan is consistent with national planning policy.

The council is also, as part of the Local Plan process, carrying out a public consultation calling for people to offer ideas for possible permanent and transit gypsy sites in the district.

The authority has a duty to find a site or sites for six permanent caravans and a transit site for travellers who are passing through the area, totalling about half a hectare (1.2 acres), and is keen to hear from landowners.

The public can comment on the Local Plan and on the gypsy site consultation at local libraries, leisure centres and at the Civic Centre.

new FREE exercise initiative has been launched in Mansfield as part of our mission to encourage more people to get fitter and healthier.

The Pilates in the Park sessions are held every Sunday from 10am to 11am at Forest Road Park (Spider Park). The classes are being led by a qualified instructor from Our Parks, a major provider of outdoor group exercise sessions across the UK, and are being funded for a year thanks to a grant from parks protection charity Fields in Trust.

It is hoped that by removing barriers to exercise, such as the class fees, and being fully inclusive of all abilities, these sessions will encourage more people to get active.

According to Public Health England, the health of people in Mansfield is generally worse than the England average. Life expectancy is more than 10 years lower

for men and eight years lower for women in the most deprived areas of Mansfield.

Helping to improve the health and wellbeing of people in the district and reducing its health inequalities is one of the council's key priorities.

The sessions are open to everyone. Participants are welcome to bring their children along but all under-15s will need to attend with an adult.

Annual voter registration

All residents in Mansfield district will soon be receiving a form asking if the information that appears on the electoral register for their address is correct.

With district, mayoral and parish council elections taking place in Mansfield district in May 2019, this is an important opportunity for residents to make sure they will be able to take part.

The forms will arrive at homes from 23 July as part of the council's annual voter registration canvass, which makes sure the electoral register is up to date.

If all the details on the form are correct, you still need to respond and can do this quickly and easily by text, online or by post. The contact details are all on the form.

If any changes are needed. this can be done online or by returning the form.

Anyone who is added to the form will not automatically be registered to vote and this will need to be done separately at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote once they have responded to the form.

Reminders will be sent out to those that do not respond before home visits are carried out in October and November. It is a legal requirement to provide the information requested and if you don't you could be fined £1,000.
