- Like many councils, we are facing money shortfalls.
- By March 2026, we may be short of over £3 million.
- Costs are going up, and more people need our services.
- We need to find ways to save money and bring in more income.

- Starting today, Monday 16 September, we are asking for your opinions.
- This consultation will last for three weeks and end on Sunday 6 October.
- Your feedback will help us decide which services are most important.

- We will use it to help plan our budget.
- We need to make some tough choices to save money and keep the council sustainable.
